

Project Courtesy Notice

Avon, Massachusetts

Dear Neighbors,

This notice is being sent as a courtesy to notify you that National Grid has the plan to construct a new substation in Avon, MA. The substation will be located on a 14-acre site off of Harrison Boulevard. This new substation is needed to answer to the growth of electrical demand in the area over the past several years. It will provide more flexibility and strength to the current system thus increasing reliability. We wanted to notify you of the proposed work in case you have any questions during the construction process.

As a local neighbor, you will see our construction crews and large construction vehicles traveling through the area, however, construction activity will be limited to the substation property. Construction activities, such as vegetation management, began in the Fall of 2014. Substation construction is expected to begin in February 2015 and to be completed by Fall 2015. Most work will take place primarily Monday through Friday however, there may be instances when occasional extended workdays and/or weekend construction may occur in order to keep the project on schedule.

I will continue to provide updates as this project progresses.

This work is part of an overall program designed to provide safe, reliable electricity for the region. If you have any questions or would like further information, please feel free to contact me.
